Prayer guides will be available this coming Sunday in your bulletin and at the Information Desk.




# PALM SUNDAY, MARCH 16



Dear Church Family,

We returned Saturday from Tuscaloosa after the sixth chemo treatment. The treatment went well. I return to Tuscaloosa on March 26 for a CT Scan and a MUGA test (this test checks the blood flow through my heart). If the CT Scan shows progress from the previous scan, the oncologist indicated there would probably be a seventh and eighth chemo treatment. The seventh treatment would take place on March 27. I fully expect to receive the two additional chemo treatments since there was such a large concentration of lymphoma prior to the beginning of treatments.

Thanks for all of your prayers. Please continue to pray for us.
