

The ladies' quilting group (Stashbusters) recently sent a handmade quilt to a mother who lost her son in the Sandy Hook School shooting. The FBC quilting group is involved in a variety of ministry projects including sewing eyeglass cases for mission trips to Central America, and quilts for the Boys Ranch. The following letter of thanks was written by the boy's grandfather who lives in Fayetteville:

Stash Busters Quilters.

I wanted to thank you and give you this picture of my daughter with the picture of herself and JT and Jesse behind her.

Scarlett's greatgrandmother, Mrs. Bert Lewis was a member of 1st Baptist all or most of her life, and that was a long one as she passed away in 1981 at the age of 104. Scarlett was born in Fayetteville in 1968 and made her

home here for a time in the 1990's.

She has started the *Jesse Lewis Chose Love Foundation* to try to get wisdom-based teaching in the public school systems. Her message at the



funeral of Jesse was to choose love over anger, and she asked everyone to replace an angry thought with a loving one, once a day. She has been most inspiring to me and to all around her during this process, and is most grateful for the outpouring of love from all over the world.

In that moment we were all one in our grief with the 20 parents who lost their kids and, it's

our hope we can remain that way in pursuit of peace, love and compassion.




