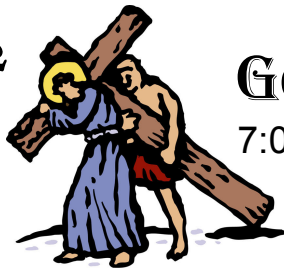

said to me, "Now, I have put my words in your mouth. Jeremiah 1:4-6, NIV

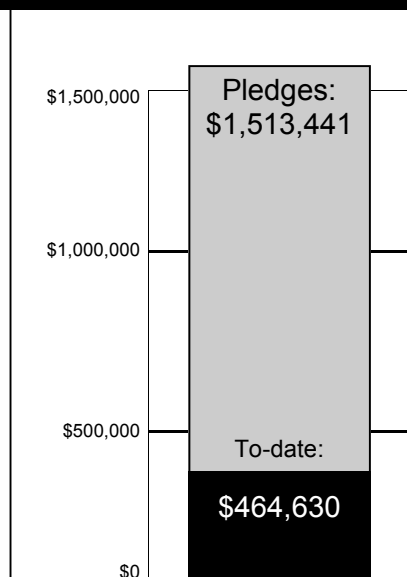
