The Church Planting team of the Washington Madison Baptist Association has asked if we would partner with a new Southern Baptist work, "The New Community Church," and church planter/pastor Andy Swart as they reach people in the northern part of Washington County and the southern part of Benton County. Pray for our committee as they seek God's wisdom and make a recommendation to the church.

During the Evening Worship service on March 30, we will be ordaining Jason Hall to the deacon ministry. This process began several months ago with his nomination by a church member. Since then, many prayers have been raised seeking God's calling and plan, Jason has shared his testimony with the deacons and the church, and there has been a time for Jason to be questioned privately by the deacon chairman as well as by the larger deacon body. The church accepted the deacons' recommendation to ordain Jason and we will joyfully do so this Sunday. We will celebrate with a reception after the worship service. Please pray for Jason and all of our deacons as these godly men lead as servants of the Lord and of First Baptist Church.

Dear First Baptist Church,

We desperately need your help in finding some Godly house parent staff.

At our Arkansas Baptist Boys Ranch we immediately need a set of houseparents for our Arapaho Cottage to care for boys ages nine to seventeen years old. We have boys waiting to be placed.

We also need a recreation director for the Boys Ranch. This person will plan and supervise both on and off campus recreational activities. These activities include camping, fun trips, a horseback program and daily activities. This position requires a mature individual who can teach responsibility, sportsmanship, safety and healthy living through a Christ centered recreational program.

At the Arkansas Baptist Children's Home we need a relief houseparent couple or single to work with our junior and senior high girls. Also, we currently have one housefather serving in Iraq. His wife is pregnant and will soon be on maternity leave. This intensifies our need.

Arkansas Baptist Promise House in Little Rock is seeking a single female houseparent. This fulltime position will soon be available. Promise House is a ministry to pregnant teens.

Perhaps there is a couple or an individual in our church that could fill one of these positions. Maybe you are aware of someone outside our church that might be interested in one of these opportunities.
