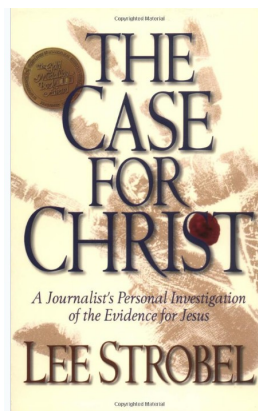
Women's Book Club

A seasoned journalist chases down the biggest story in history-is there credible evidence that Jesus of Nazareth really is the Son of God?

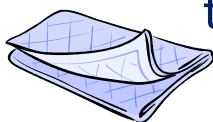

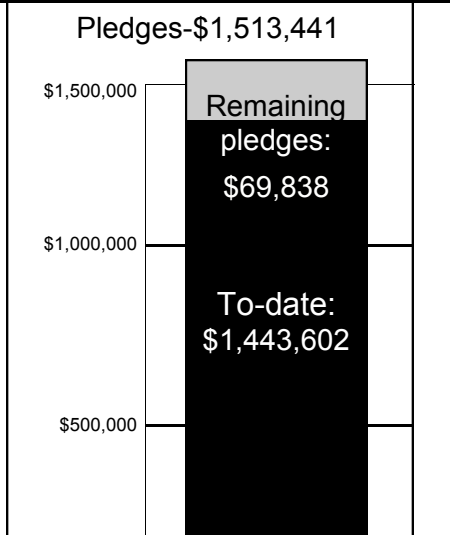
