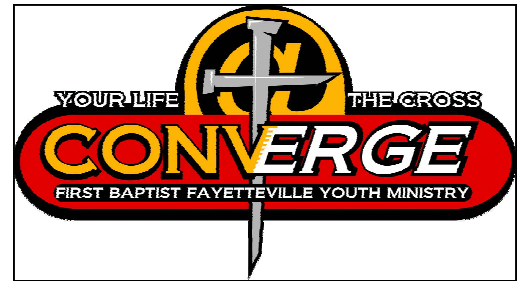
Easter Eggs & Candy Needed!
