On June 1, First Baptist Church will become the owners of the building and property which formerly housed Immanuel Baptist Church. Here is some background information:

First Baptist Church began a mission at the corner of Duncan and West Rock in the 1940's. Through a generous gift from the Gardenhire family (Lola Harris's parents), land and a building were made available. In 1950, the mission became Immanuel Baptist Church (IBC). The property that was deeded to them included a stipulation that if IBC ever ceased cooperating with Washington-Madison Baptist Association and the Arkansas Baptist State Convention, the property would revert to the ownership of First Baptist Church.

In March, IBC voted to merge with another congregation in Lowell, thereby ending over 50 years of ministry in Fayetteville. They are currently in the process of moving out of the building. Their pastor, Chuck Bengston, has a great appreciation for the heritage they have enjoyed at the property. Pray for IBC and the newly formed Legacy Baptist Church in Lowell.

The formal transition is planned for June 1. Pastor Chuck is committed to allowing Underground (a youth Bible study and luncheon led by our student ministry) to complete the school year without interruption. Beginning June 1, FBC will be responsible for the property. The church voted Sunday evening to authorize funding for an inspection and necessary legal work on the church property (as well as on an adjacent house owned by IBC but not included in the transfer of property).

Even more importantly, we will have an opportunity for ministry we had not anticipated. How will God lead FBC to make a difference for His Kingdom using this newly acquired resource? Will it be used for ethnic work? ministry to the working poor? outreach to the students – high school and university? Something else we cannot even envision today?

Pray for God to reveal His will for the property and how we can be part of His plan. Our desire is to be faithful in whatever God provides.
