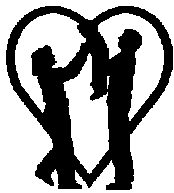

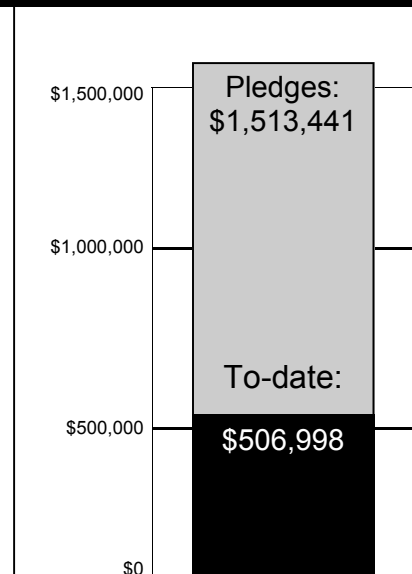

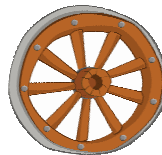
VBS Musical Drama Tryouts
