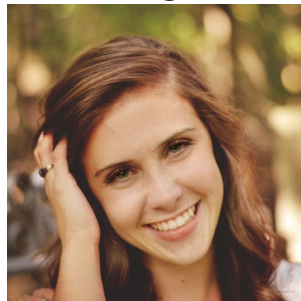

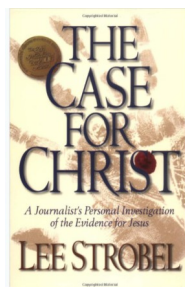
Kitchen Shower
