God has performed an amazing work through the faithfulness of His people at First Baptist Church. Just fourteen months after completion of the major renovation of the sanctuary and two years after the start of Called to Build, Called to Grow (our three year capital campaign commitment), we are debt-free. Praise the Lord!

Thank you to each person and family that has given faithfully and generously to allow the church to accomplish this task in two years. Your giving allowed the church to avoid paying unnecessary interest. Because your giving was above and beyond your tithe for the on-going work of the

church, we have continued fully funding every ministry and reaching people with the gospel of Christ.

With \$1,900,329 received and another \$327,470 in pledges anticipated to be received, the church continues to look forward to the work of Phase II, beginning with the replacement of the steeple. The Phase II Committee is working diligently to bring the steeple replacement to fruition and to prepare the church for moving forward with our plans.

As a reminder, Phase II (and Phase III) includes the complete remodel of the North Building (formerly the Goff-McNair building). The first step of this major project (work on the lower level of the building) will allow us to increase our space for our growing preschool department. The next step (work on the upper level of the building) will provide new and accessible space for our three older adult departments and update and expand space for our university students. When all of this work is completed, we will have additional space for every age group: babies, preschoolers, children, youth, college, and every adult age. We will have space for everyone.

Let us celebrate God's bountiful provision as this first phase – the sanctuary renovation – has been completed and fully paid. As we rejoice together, let us also be sharpening our focus for the work God has placed before us. There are many more people in Fayetteville, NW Arkansas, and to the far corners of the earth whom God has called us to reach. As God's people, let us renew our commitment to do whatever it takes to win our world for Christ.


