## RUSSIA PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

In December 2008, our church voted to partner with a church in the Ekaterinburg, in the Sverdlovskaya Oblast Region of Russia. This city of two million, located just east of the Ural Mountains in the western edge of Asia, is the "gateway to Siberia."

Mike Paslay is the staff coordinator for this partnership. He and a team from our church initiated our partnership with the Stream of Life Church last October. While there, they met Rev. Pavel Reseysev, his wife, Angelika and their children, Dennis, Margarita, and Mark. Since then, their newest

addition, David, was born the last day of winter, February 28.

Pavel is bivocational; working full-time in a secular position to support his growing family while leading his congregation of over 120 members. His flock is the oldest in Ekaterinburg, one of the largest, and the only Baptist church in the city that owns its property and building.

Worship services typically last

over three hours and the Sunday we attended, youth remained at the church until 10:00 p.m. Few members have cars and many, like the Reseysevs, travel on public transportation to attend, some as long as two hours! In a recent email, Pavel shared that Easter Sunday they could not seat all of the 170 worshippers! Over 100 attended a recent youth conference at the church.

Pavel demonstrates a heart of gratitude for these blessings and asks us to pray for:

- new pastors and lay leaders in all the congregations in Russia.
- new believers now attending discipleship classes as they await baptism.
- financial resources to build a second floor to accommodate 300 in worship.
- speedy success in gaining required government approval for their expansion.
- an upcoming stewardship/financial seminar to give his members skills they lack in managing their meager incomes.
- Children and Youth Camps scheduled this summer.
- personal strength and stamina as he manages his energy and time between his family, his church, and his job.
- their continued efforts to reach out to the community around the church, especially a nearby homeless shelter for unwed mothers, orphans, and throwaway/runaway children.

Please pray for Pavel, Jesse Hoyer, our IMB coordinator in Ekaterinburg, and Mike Paslay as they seek God's leadership regarding our next trip to Ekaterinburg:


