The images of the devastation in Moore, OK, startle our senses. As I checked the news last night and this morning, fatalities had been reported at 51 and even higher with many more suffering injury. Remarkably, that number has been declining with "only" 24 confirmed deaths. After seeing the images, many people flashed back to Joplin's disaster and considered the fatalities could dramatically rise.

Our hearts break for our neighbors facing physical and financial loss. We can picture ourselves searching for our kids at the schools, sifting through shattered belongings to rescue a treasured memory, wondering where we will work or live or worship. How will we feed our family today, tomorrow, next week?

We want to help. What can we do? At this writing, there are two primary needs: prayer and money. Both are needed in abundance.

I am confident that you have already been praying. Please pray again. As you see a picture of a person in distress, pray specifically for that one. When you hear about a family in grief, pray for that family. Seek God's face. He hears. He cares. He comes to the rescue of the wounded, broken, and weary. Let us trust in Him.

I am also confident that you are ready to give. Be as generous as you would hope people would be with you in a time of disaster. And, be wise as you give. There are many good groups and organizations that will request money. Some will use it wisely, but others will not. Give so that your money will go to help people, not to pay for administrative costs or salaries.

Because you tithe through First Baptist Church, our partnership with the Arkansas Baptist State Convention has already supported the foundation for disaster relief ministries. 


