

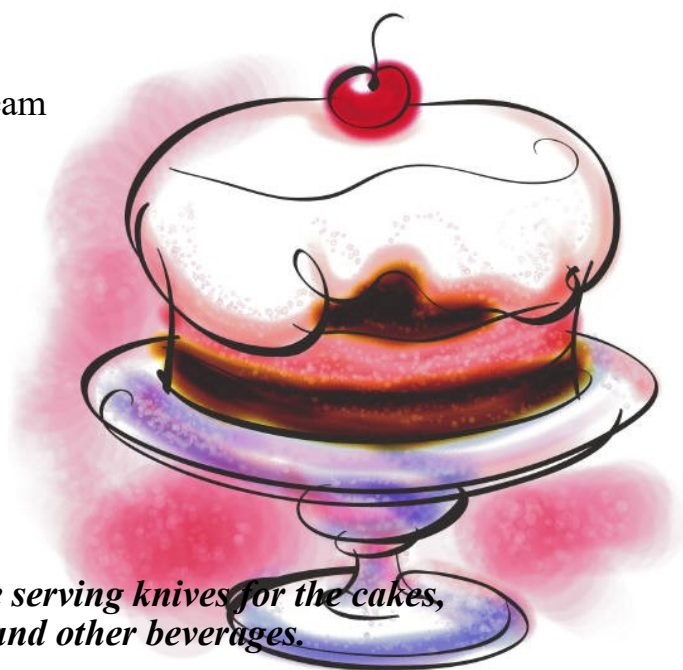
1st Annual Family Cake Bake & Sandwich Supper
