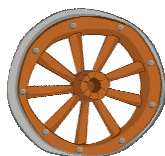

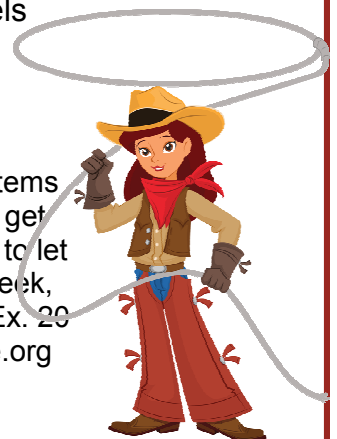

Decorating items needed for VBS::

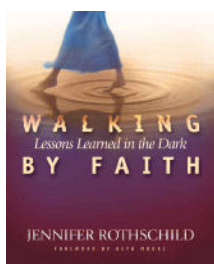
- ◆ Tall or short slim Christmas trees

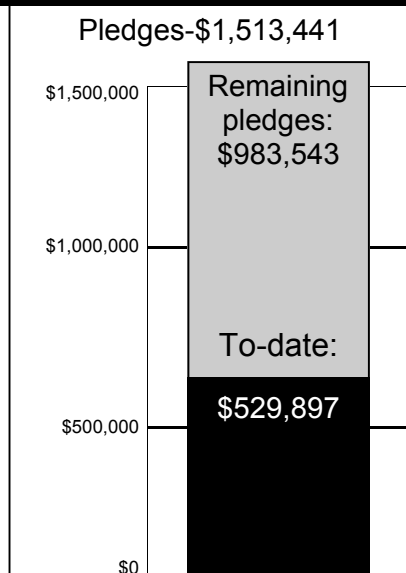
