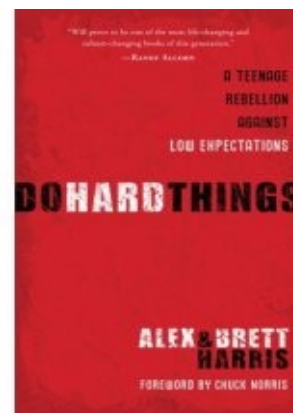
*To whom can we turn to motivate a new generation of GIANTS? I've found the answer. Alex and Brett Harris and their book, *Do Hard Things*.*

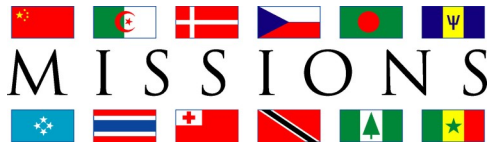

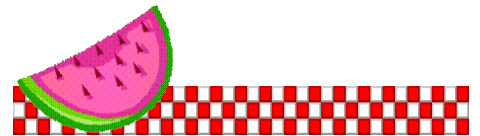

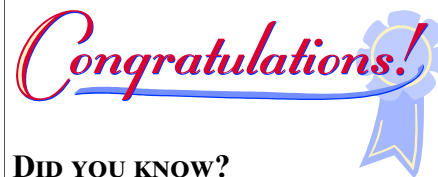
