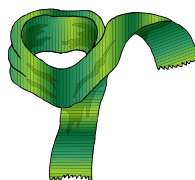


## Scarf/Quilt Project

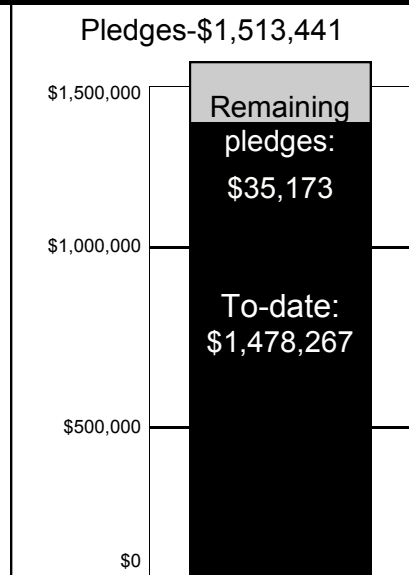
