News reports and articles have trumpeted the legalization of gay marriages in California as a result of that state's supreme court rulings. As recently as 2000 the voters of California approved by a strong majority Proposition 22 which stated, "Only marriage between a man and a woman is valid or recognized in California." Californians will be voting again this fall to protect traditional marriage, but the entire nation will continue to hear a barrage of information in support of homosexuality and gay marriage.

I am grateful that the Southern Baptist Convention, through the 2000 Baptist Faith and Message and numerous approved resolutions, has clarified our firm conviction of the biblical stance that homosexuality is sin and that marriage is designed by God to be for one man and one woman. Yet too many Christians have been swayed by the constant cultural mantra that homosexuality is okay. "If you only knew the gay people I know (family, friend, co-worker) then you would realize that they are good people who love each other. Who are we to say that it is wrong?" These and similar statements reveal a lack of understanding of what God says or a willingness to discard the truth of the Bible for the current cultural trends.

Here are a few of the things the Bible says about homosexuality and marriage:

But Jesus said to them, "From the beginning of creation, God MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE. FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER." Mark 10:5-7

Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God.

1 Corinthians 6:9-10

But we know that the Law is good and is made for those who are lawless and rebellious, . . . for murderers and immoral men and homosexuals and kidnappers and liars and perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound teaching.

1 Timothy 1:8-10

For this reason God gave them over to degrading passions; for their women exchanged the natural function for that which is unnatural, and in the same way also the men abandoned the natural function of the woman and burned in their desire toward one another, men with men committing indecent acts.
