Many of you have asked me how we enjoyed our time at the Southern Baptist Convention annual meeting in Indianapolis. You have told me that you saw almost nothing about the convention in the local newspapers. The absence of news about our annual meeting is indicative of how we demonstrated overall unity of spirit and focus on our mission. There was no divisiveness, no disruption, and nothing "newsworthy."

In other words, it was a great convention! The messengers to the convention and the messages of the convention were focused on our purpose to love God and one another as we reach this world with the redemptive message of Jesus Christ. It is wonderful to be part of a denomination that understands its primary purpose for existence is to assist the local church to be more effective and efficient as we link hearts with one another to take the gospel across the street and around the world.

One topic of discussion for the last few years has been how to report more accurately our total membership. Official membership records profess over 16 million members, but only 6 million people are in worship services during a typical week. Recognizing the importance of a regenerate (authentically saved) church body as well as the responsibility of the church to care for its members (equipping, encouraging, disciplining, teaching), a resolution was adopted to encourage local churches to be more biblical and judicious in their membership.

Our own church, for example, has a total membership of 2,892 – 1,272 "resident" members and 1,620 "non-resident" members – even though we have no contact with a large number of them and on our highest attendance days (Easter) we have around 900 people present. Wouldn't it be nice to know how many "real" members we have? Some in our official records have no doubt joined other churches, some have passed away, and some have dropped out of church. Do we not have an obligation to clarify our membership so that we may more intentionally care for those who are part of our family?

To live together as a church family, let us commit to be more accurate in knowing our membership so that we can be more truthful in our reporting and more loving in ministering.
