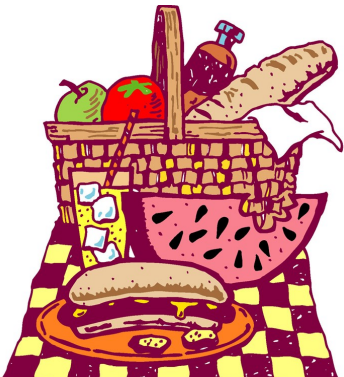

College Ministry

On the mission trip June 12-21st we took 8 people from here and added 2 more students from Georgia which gave us a total of ten people to work in Cambridge, Massachusetts. We worked in the Portuguese Baptist Church which was ten minutes from both Harvard & MIT universities. Reginaldo Krukalis is the pastor and he was the Moore's pastor in Sao Paulo, Brazil and personal friend.

This trip was the best of an "international" trip without leaving the US. While most of the church members are from Brazil, many also speak English. They hosted us in their homes with Brazilian food & fellowship. The church is a small, struggling congregation in the midst of over 100,000 students. Our goal was to help them reach their neighborhood with the love of Jesus Christ through "deeds of construction", "acts of kindness" and also with a verbal witness.

We shared everyday with neighbors, delivery people, and people who were just walking by. Also we went door-to-door and visited with over 500 people in the area and invited them to a cookout on Sunday afternoon. Over 30 first-time guests came and met the

members.

Our team worked very hard moving a 3 foot retaining wall, hauling 150 wheelbarrels of dirt, planting a new flower garden, building a new prayer garden, removing 5 tons of debris in one day, building a new wall and a sidewalk with 5 yards of concrete. We replaced rotten wood in numerous places, and prepared the parsonage and front of the church for painting.

While this gave the church a "new, fresh" look and an important entrance with sidewalk and new doors, I believe that the neighborhood became aware of a church with a desire to welcome and minister in the midst of this community. Sightseeing in Boston is always spectacular but having people gain new "sight" for lives and souls around them is so much more so!

Thank you for your prayers and support and we needed all of them as no one was injured and God was magnified and glorified during our time there.
