"Prepare your provisions, for within three days you are to pass over this Jordan to go in to take possession of the land that the LORD your God is giving you to possess."

Joshua 1:11

The simple instructions from Joshua overshadow the fact that the lives of all the Israelites would soon be changed. In a short time, they would cross the Jordan into the land promised to Abraham and overthrow the city of Jericho, the beginning of the conquest of the land. Joshua initiated the transition with the brief, "Prepare your provisions."

Transitions, even good transitions that are wanted, can test our mettle.

There are often obstacles - physical and emotional - that must be faced in the process. Your transition may be moving from your home of many years into another residence. "It's the right move during this season of life" can be true, but little comfort. Or, you may be leaving your parents' home to branch out on your own. Everyone is ready, but the emotions and finances can be tough.

The challenge of transitions is leaving the familiar, safe, and comfortable to endeavor into the unfamiliar, unknown, and uncomfortable. Yet, it is when we leave "here" and go "there" that we are embarking on a journey that gives us the opportunity "to take possession of the land that the Lord your God is giving you to possess." New territory can only be taken if we go into new territory.

Preparation is essential for transitions. The families of Israel packed everything they owned and moved forward when the time was ready. In our transitions, we prepare ourselves, knowing that we will be ready to move forward when God calls. For example, last Sunday our college ministry moved from the North Building to Mitchell Hall in advance of the construction.

Much preparation took place before the transition.

Is God working toward a transition in your life? Perhaps He has made it clear that a change is coming in your school or work or finances. Do not be afraid. God has promised to be with you. While the transition may not be easy, it is the pathway to following His leadership and taking possession of new land for His glory. Prepare your provisions and trust the Lord.

Finally in 1939 she was able to leave for Nigeria where she spent the next 39 years. She died in 2001. Her influence lives on at First Baptist Fayetteville, as well all across the United States. 
