

# 2009 FBC YOUTH SUMMER CHALLENGE!

# "Therefore go and make DISCIPLES" Matt. 28:19

I am so excited to see God work through each of you. You are so amazing each summer to take these challenges and RUN with them. We are still seeing fruit from last years challenge of "Do Hard Things.!" This challenge will prompt you to spend time obeying the Great Commission to "go and make disciples." Let's stop talking about it and DO IT!! Last summer, some of you encountered a powerful scripture –once again–let's LIVE IT!

# "Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ." 1 Cor. 11:1

<u>The Challenge</u>: You have been taught, now is your opportunity to teach others. Use your summer to serve your God in a BIG, life-changing way by praying and choosing one person to disciple.

## Details:

- 1. Pray, and pray and did I mention PRAY? Ask God to guide you in choosing one person whom you will meet with at least 4 times this summer between June 3<sup>rd</sup> and August 5<sup>th</sup> for the purpose of discipleship.
- 2. Choose a person who is close to your age.
- 3. Choose a person who is your same gender. (no exceptions)
- 4. Choose a person who is not a Christian or who does not attend a Bible-believing church.
- 5. Choose a regular time and place to meet for approximately 1 hour sessions.
- 6. Pray about how, through this opportunity, you might lead this person to the Lord or invite them to be a part of our church.
- 7. Consider attending **Deeper Life** this summer (Thursday mornings 10:30–12:00 beginning June 25<sup>th</sup>). **Deeper Life** is designed to help you research, prepare, write, and teach your own Bible study.
- 8. Choose a Bible study for you to lead with your disciple. Be sure the gospel is clearly presented in your 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> lesson. You may create one yourself from **Deeper Life**, by asking for help from a strong Christian adult, by searching a reputable Bible Study website for material, or by purchasing a book/curriculum from a Christian book store.
- 9. Share all above information with Steve as soon as possible in written form.
- 10. ALL students who complete this challenge will be recognized before our church body. Wouldn't it bring great glory to God to have <u>tons</u> of you there to present? Wouldn't it be even more incredible to have been an instrument God uses to bring new lives into a relationship with HIM?!?
