Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you.

Romans 16:16

Newcomers have a hard time. When they visit our church (or any church) for the first time, they are uncertain about where to park or what doors will be the best to enter. Even as they find the guest parking lot and walk through the "correct" door, they feel uncertain and disoriented. Strange faces (in the new sense!) greet them in the parking lot or at the doors.

Sometimes newcomers feel like there is a spotlight on them.

Sometimes they feel as if they are invisible to the hustle and bustle of the crowd.

Even as someone walks them to a Sunday School class or the Sanctuary, newcomers get turned around. "Can I find my way back to the car later?" If they put children in the nursery or in a Sunday School class, they think, "How will I find my way back to the kids later?" Losing the car is one thing. Losing the kids?

Then they walk into a room filled with 500-600 people. Everyone else seems to know one another and to be known. Everyone else knows where to sit. Everyone else knows what to expect.

Paul often devoted time in his pastoral letters for greetings. Romans 16 contains twenty-two greetings with a very specific instruction to welcome (greet) one another. Here are two suggestions for us to help newcomers know they are welcomed when they are our guests.

We will reserve our guest parking lot for guests. Because the construction project has removed part of our parking space for a season, we have been more crowded in the parking lot and needing to use every available space. As a result, our guest parking lot has been squeezed. Let me encourage us all to reserve our guest spaces for guests, especially as we move toward the start of the school year. Please, those who are able, park at the bank, at the courthouse, at AutoZone, behind Marvins, and in other more remote spaces. This allows our folks who need more accessible parking to know they will find an available space in our main parking lot.

We will introduce ourselves (by name) to people. If you don't know someone, they probably don't know you, either. Some of them may be members, but you need to greet them, too! [July 31 is nametag Sunday. We will provide nametags for everyone so can learn those names we are too embarrassed to ask. Again.] If the person is a guest, invite them to walk with you or to sit with you. Make sure they receive a worship folder. Is a group/class having lunch? Invite them to join you. Our goal is to include, encourage, and welcome.

In all of our efforts, we remember that newcomers are guests. Other places may treat them as intruders taking the best parking or the best seats. We greet them as guests: honored, welcomed, and loved with the love of Christ.


