During this Sunday's business meeting, I will recommend that we add an earlier worship service. If approved, the times for our morning activities will be 8:30 worship, 9:45 Sunday School, and 11:00 worship, with 15 minutes between each event. The pastoral staff has been discussing this since May.

I have presented this idea to our Sunday School directors as well as our deacon body and received positive feedback with honest discussions about the challenges of adding an early worship service.

As I have prayed about this during the past few months and seeking God's will for FBC, the question that keeps surfacing is essential to all that we do: Who can we reach that we are not reaching now? Specific faces come to my mind of folks who have wanted to worship with us but cannot due to work and other requirements. I am energized by the thought of reaching new people with the gospel and providing opportunities for worship.

There will be significant challenges. More people will need to step up to serve in our childcare ministry. This is a wonderful service to families of preschoolers. Linda Dilley does an excellent job organizing teams for extended session (ETC) each week, but she cannot be in all of the rooms. We need at least 20 new people to volunteer to serve once every month or two, helping our preschoolers learn about the love of Jesus while their parents - who already serve in ETC - enjoy time in worship.

We will need to add to our excellent teams serving in music and media.

While many of our folks are joyfully willing to serve in two services, not everyone is able to do so each week. Perhaps you have put off joining the choir. You are greatly needed. Our media team can use more volunteers now.

Perhaps you have been blessed with playing an instrument. Talk with Mike Paslay about how you can use your abilities for the glory of God.

Other kinks in our schedule - the way we are used to doing things - will no doubt need to be adjusted. But if God is leading us forward, He will use all of us to bring glory to His name. Let us be willing to do whatever God calls us to do that we might reach more people for sake of the gospel.


