at FBC has meant to them. While you may not have had the best of experiences before with your student, I want to ask you to consider how easy it is to say "we care". However, this is a way that it can *really* happen in deed, not just with words. Every year we have the opportunity to impact the lives of students who have the rest of their lives to reach people for the kingdom of God. I cannot begin to tell you how your ministry to our students makes such a key difference in their lives.

Inviting them to lunch (especially a home-cooked meal) or taking them out with your family is greatly appreciated, as is making sure that they receive a "care" package of cookies or other goodies near test times or other events like birthdays or occasions when some can't make it home. You and your family can make a great difference, and it just takes a few hours each month — that's right — each month. We are asking you to make contact and follow up on a monthly basis with

"your" student(s). We have discovered that it is really easier to have two students than just one because they relate better to one another and to their FBC Home Away From Home family. I find it is very easy to invite them for pizza on a Sunday evening or to meet with me here for a meal on Wednesday evenings.

Quite frankly, they enjoy a note or card, or going to a movie or meal. These simple gestures can really make a difference. This year we need 35 homes to make sure that we can accommodate all of our students. Please pray about this important ministry and your willingness to be available to our university students.

Sign up with our office or with Steve Moore as soon as possible because the students will be coming our way shortly. Many will be arriving in one month. Summer break is already over halfway over! The University department really appreciates our families here at FBC. Our students need to know you so they can feel at home here like we do!
