

Issues such as wills, guardians, trusts, gift and estate taxes, and charitable giving techniques will be covered in the seminar.

The seminar will be led by Dr. W. David Moore, President of the Arkansas Baptist Foundation in Little Rock. The Foundation is the trust agency of the Arkansas Baptist State Convention and specializes in estate planning and charitable giving. Currently, the Foundation manages around \$160 million in assets which support numerous Baptist causes as chosen by the donors.

A graduate of Samford University, Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, and Baylor University, Dr. Moore is an ordained minister who pastored churches for 19 years. A graduate of the Cannon School of Foundation Management, Moore is a Certified Financial Planner (CFP®) practitioner and a Certified Specialist in Estate Planning (CSEP). He also teaches Estate Planning at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock in the School of Business. He is married and has two daughters.
