



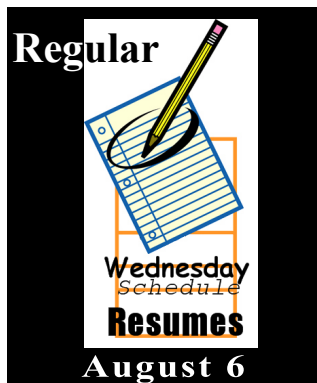

He also teaches Estate Planning at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock in the School of Business. He is married and has two daughters.

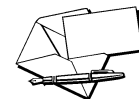
