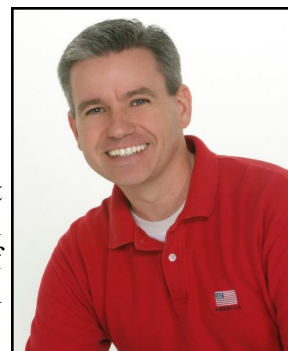
Saturday, August 12 (this Saturday!) will be an important work day at the Duncan Avenue Campus (formerly the Immanuel Baptist Church property). We will be joining with the members of Grace Chinese Christian Church to paint the classrooms, clean toys, clear out clutter, and organize rooms. Much work has already been accomplished at the Duncan Avenue Campus, especially with the yard work. But, before the space is used by others, we will want to give it a thorough cleaning inside and outside.

Sunday, August 20 will be an historical date and the primary reason for the above mentioned work day. On this date, Grace Chinese Christian Church will be transitioning from meeting in the North Building of First Baptist Church to meeting at the Duncan Avenue Campus. This is an important step of faith for this congregation which will provide them an opportunity to grow in many ways. They will be able to expand their base of workers, grow in stewardship, and develop a more distinctive identity. Pray for Grace Church during this exciting time.

During our July Business Meeting, the Missions/Evangelism Committee recommended a motion to offer Grace Chinese Christian Church the opportunity to begin meeting at the Duncan Avenue Campus. With church approval, Chris Puckett, the committee chairman, sat down with leadership from Grace Church and formally presented the offer and worked through a tentative agreement. The Missions/Evangelism Committee met immediately after this meeting to confirm the arrangements; the next weekend, Grace Church accepted the offer.

Our churches will continue to be connected as we labor together for the gospel of Christ. While Grace Church works to develop trained workers, First Baptist Church will provide Bible study for children and youth each Sunday. We intend to invite members of Grace Church to special events at First Baptist Church and hope to join them in their special celebrations. Together we will focus on reaching Fayetteville, NW Arkansas and the ends of the earth with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Pray for both churches during the transition. Come Saturday, and help us prepare for the first Sunday of worship at the new location.

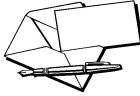

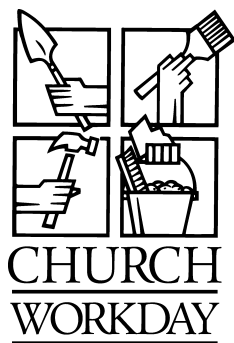

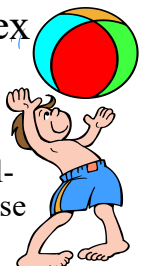
