In January 2009 they appeared at the 17th Annual Trumpet Awards Ceremony in Atlanta, Georgia and in August of that year, they were asked to sing on Black Entertainment Television's awarding winning Bobby Jones Gospel Show. The choir released their second CD, "Live to Worship" in March of this year.

Skate Party


