In 2004 Charles Moore relocated from Georgia to Northwest Arkansas. As a former member of the Georgia Mass Choir, he eagerly sought a similar group to be a part of in our area. Discovering that no such group existed, over the next three years, he responded to God's leadership in founding the Arkansas Gospel Mass Choir. The choir is comprised of well over one hundred men and women from across the state of Arkansas and the Tulsa area. The singers come from many different congregations and denominations, united in their passion to share the message of Jesus Christ through their music.

Singing as the individual member's schedules allow, the group has sung across our state and nation. In January 2009 they appeared at the 17th Annual Trumpet Awards Ceremony in Atlanta, Georgia and in August of that year, they were asked to sing on Black Entertainment Television's awarding winning Bobby Jones Gospel Show. The choir released their second CD, "Live to Worship" in March of this year.

Sunday afternoon's concert is free and promises to be a fitting close to our Summer Concert Series. Plan to be present for this unique concert and bring your family and friends.
