
WEDNESDAY COLLEGE STUDIES FOR MEN & WOMEN:



EKU MISSION HOSPITAL IN NIGERIA TO RECEIVE FULL DEN-TAL OFFICE EQUIPMENT

Sisters Juanita Duncan and Arletha Honeycutt were left with a full dental office when their brother, Dr. J Vannes Boone, died in February, 2007. They were hoping to give it as a mission gift in memory of their brother. Their mother, Eleanor Howell, was a contemporary of Josephine Skaggs and knew and loved her and her mission work in Africa. Their prayer was answered in July, 2008, when a woman, whose mother had started a mission hospital in Nigeria, came to their door and inquired about the dental equipment. It was an answer to their prayer and filled a great need for the Eku hospital.

Texas Baptist Men handled all the packing, moving, and crating. When it arrives in Nigeria, the daughter, Mary Kay Posey and her husband Fred, along with the Texas Baptist Men, will install it in a waiting dental suite in memory of Dr. Boone. The sisters stand in awe and joy as they watch God at work with blessings for this Nigerian Baptist Hospital Compound at Eku operated by "Walking in Love Ministries."
