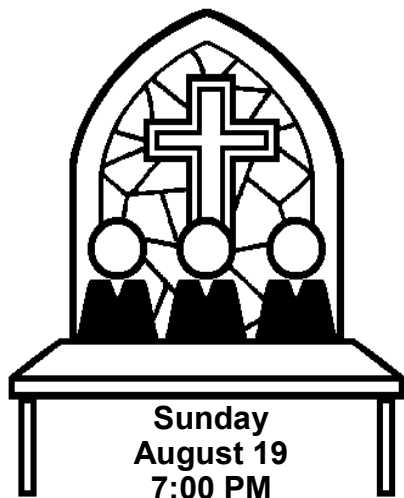
## Church Pictorial Directory

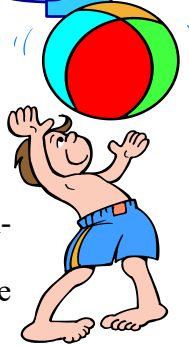
