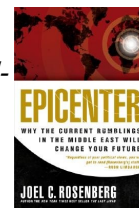


WEDNESDAY COLLEGE STUDIES FOR MEN & WOMEN:

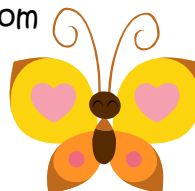

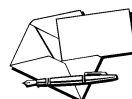


Bright Lights

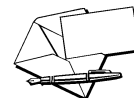
