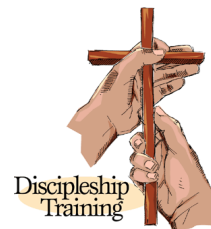


Fall Discipleship Training Schedule

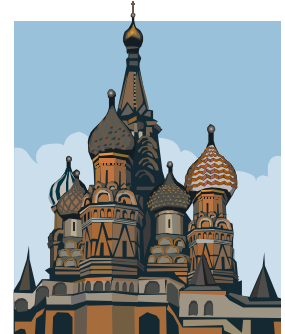

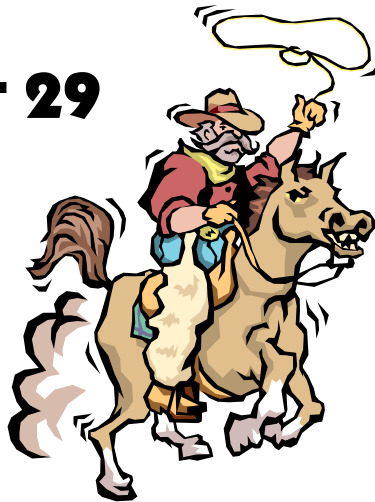
