By not replicating Sunday mornings, we will strive to reach people we do not currently reach, but the larger goal is to strengthen believers to make a difference in our community.

On Wednesday evenings, we have a remarkable number of families who are Enriched by the fellowship and unity that come through the shared meal, music, and missions, as well as the prayer time and Bible study, teachers' meetings, and other studies.
