During the August Business Session, the church approved a motion from the Stewardship Committee to transfer \$125,000 from the budget reserve fund to the *Called to Build. Called to Grow* account. The purpose of this transfer was to pay down the bank note acquired during the sanctuary renovation. No more money will be borrowed for the sanctuary renovation and, because of your faithful giving, only \$350,000 remains to have the debt completely paid.

This is astounding! In less than eighteen months since the start of our three year *Called to Build*. *Called to Grow* stewardship campaign, the church has been able to pay over \$1.5 million. My hope is that we will be able to complete the task and be debt free before the new year begins. The sooner the \$350,000 is paid, the more interest will be saved.

Here are three ways we can pay this off: 1. If you made a 3-year commitment to the *Called to Build*. *Called to Grow* campaign, please consider giving it sooner. Perhaps God has blessed you beyond all that you could ask or think and you want to express that in completing your commitment this year. 2. If you have joined First Baptist Church since we began the building program, please consider joining your church family in completing this project. You may complete an official commitment card or simply note your gift on a tithing envelope. If you want more information the project and our goals, give me a call. 3. Tithe. Our practice as a church is to keep some emergency money on hand, while working to be good stewards with all God has entrusted to us. As our budget receipts grow, we prayerfully utilize all of the resources for missions and ministry, including paying off the sanctuary renovation.

Thank you for your faithfulness to be good stewards. Thank you for your commitment to accomplish all that God has commanded us.
