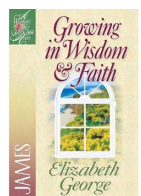


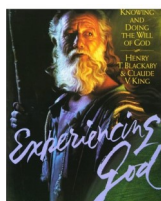

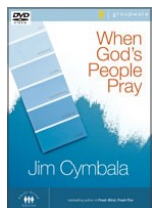
SUNDAYS AT 5:00 PM BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 7

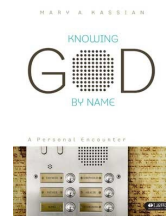

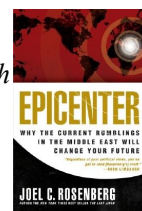
WEDNESDAY COLLEGE STUDIES FOR MEN & WOMEN:

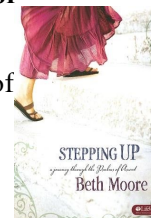

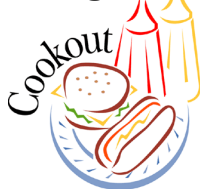

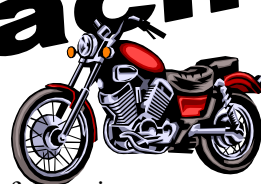
