- Bro. Pavel Reseev is pastor of our partnership church in Ekaterinburg, Russia. He and his wife, Angelika, have four children. Recently their oldest son, Mark, made his public profession of faith in Jesus! Unlike our American pattern, Russian children must wait until their adolescent years to profess their faith, be baptized, and join the church.

• After praying for fifteen years, the Reseevs now have their own

apartment. Until recently, the six of them shared a single bedroom in a three room flat they occupied along with Pavel's parents and his older sister and her child.

REQUESTS:

- Pray for Ludmila, a Russian woman, struggling with seeing salvation as a decision between the Orthodox Church (the Russian way) and the Protestant Church (the American way). Pray that God would continue to woo her, leading her to understand that she can be a follower of Jesus without abandoning her "Russianness."
- Pray for *Journeywomen*, Becca and Amanda, as they prepare for their first English Cafe on September 8. Ask God to give them opportunities to meet many people, to reveal clearly who He's seeking, and to bless this new approach in drawing people into spiritual conversations, naturally and with ease.

CHALLENGE:

- Our co-laborers see God at work already in the hearts and lives of people in Ekaterinburg. Read *Acts 8:26-40*. They pray that just as God put Phillip in the path of the Ethiopian, He will put our friends in the paths of seekers, making His glory seen in Ekaterinburg.

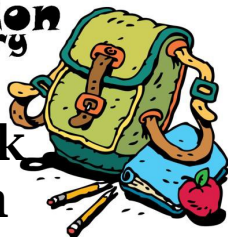

Center Time Buddies -

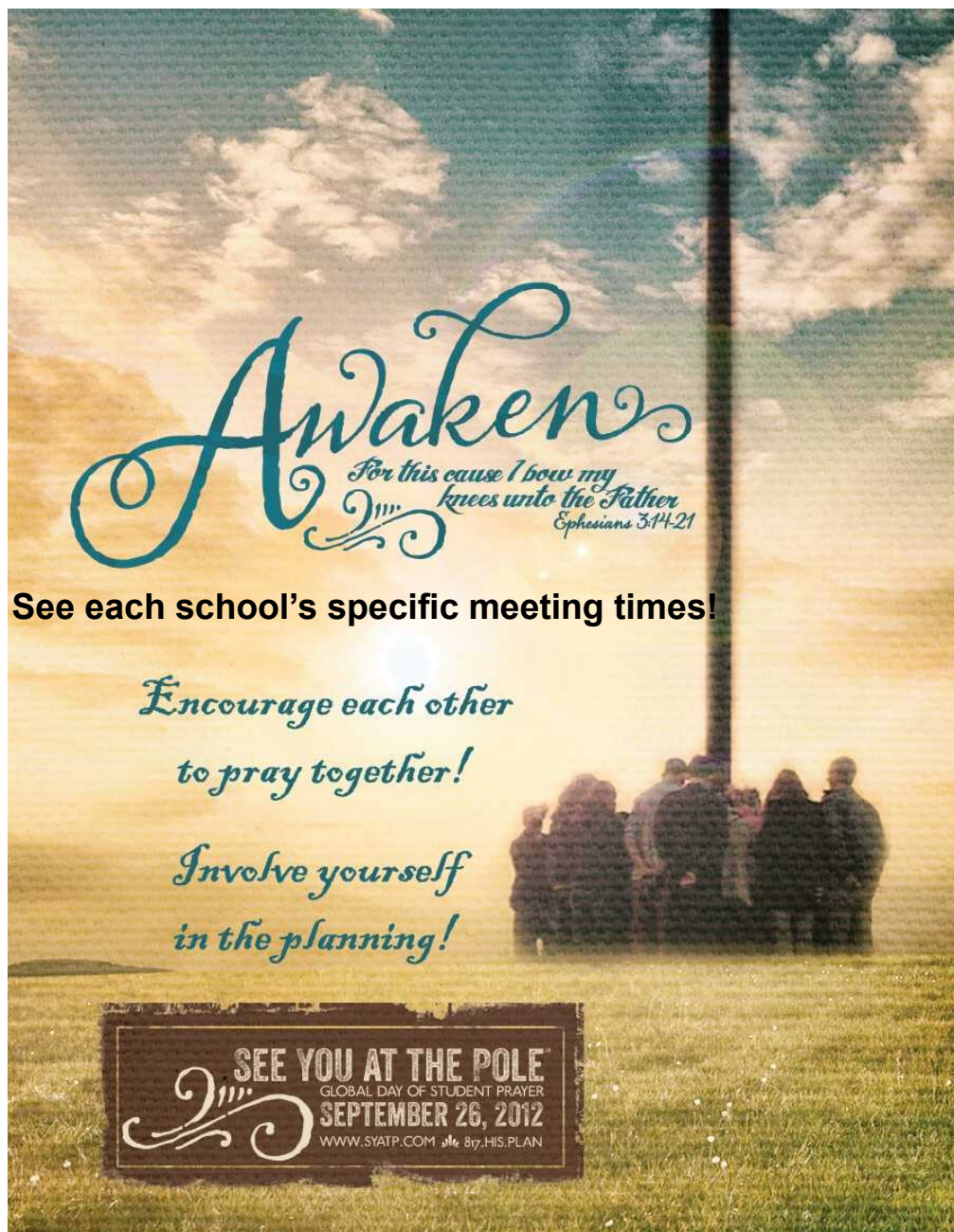
20-30 volunteers will be needed for one hour a week to go into the classroom to help children one-on-one during their center time.

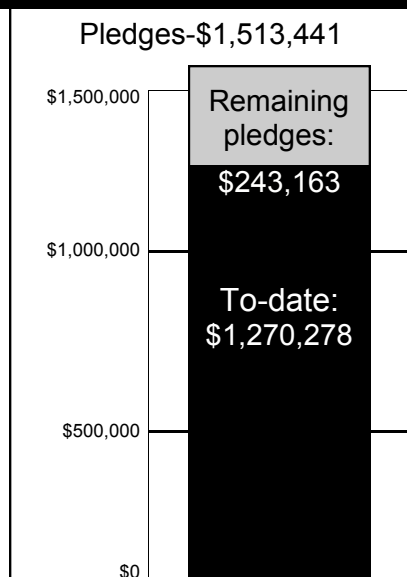
