



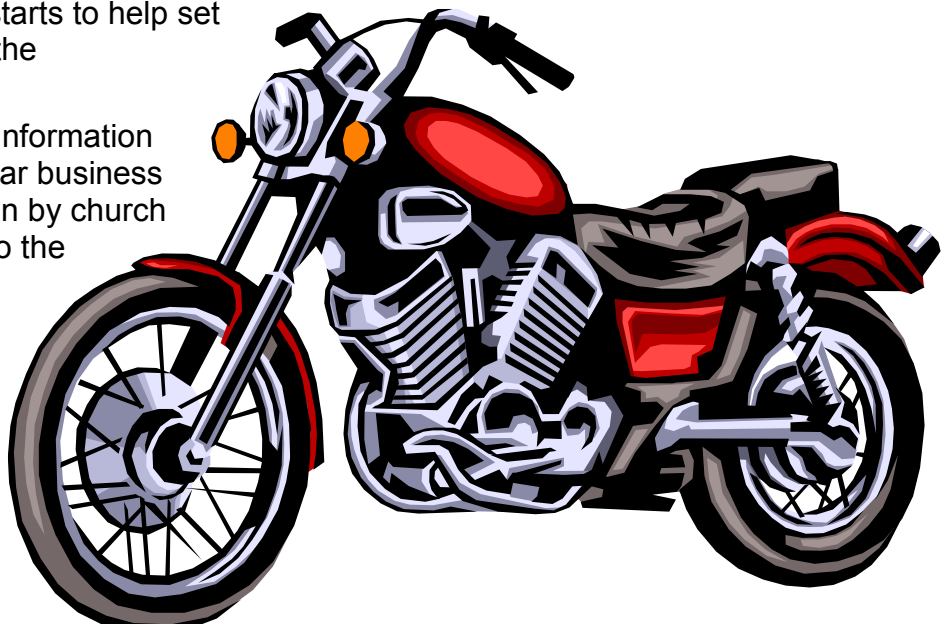
BIKES, BLUES & BBQ OUTREACH MINISTRY

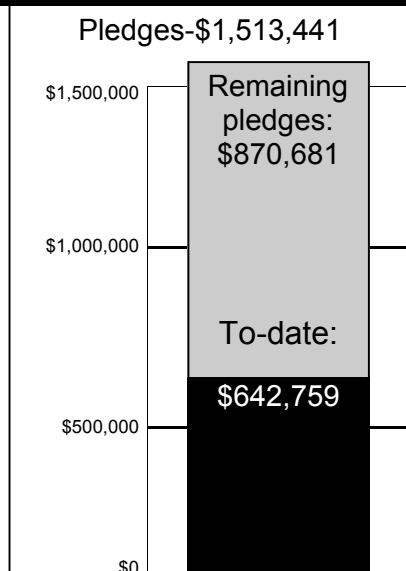
