First Baptist Church recognizes that we do not simply do missions as an extra activity to the other tasks we accomplish. We have been called and commissioned by Jesus to be His witnesses and it is our central activity. Telling people about Jesus is our mission.

Thank you for telling your neighbors, co-workers, and friends about Jesus.
