There will be a special called business meeting Sunday, October 10, following Engage Worship. The only item on the agenda will be to receive a motion from the Phase Two Committee to accept the construction bid for the reconstruction and remodeling of the North Building, building a connecting foyer between the North Building and the Sanctuary along College Avenue, and adding a parking area on the NW end of the church property (the field between our current lot and the red house). Here is the specific motion:

The Phase Two Committee moves the approval of construction bids in the amount of \$3,757,916. Additional expected costs include architectural services, engineering fees, furnishings, and possible change orders for an approximate total cost of \$4,335,000.

Several months ago the church approved a total budget of \$3,832,500 and the committee had been led to believe that Phase 2/3 could be completed for that amount. As I wrote previously, when bids came back in July they were much higher than anticipated. After much prayer and effort, some adjustments were made to the drawings and they were resubmitted for bids in a broader area. While the costs did not come down to the original estimates, they did come down.

The Phase Two Committee is ready to get construction started. While we were able to expand some of the classrooms in the Lower Auditorium, more and improved space is greatly needed for other adult departments and classes, the university department, and our student ministry. Better access is needed for our senior adults. These are important and needed changes for us to reach more people with the gospel.

If you have any questions about the project, please ask me or one of the committee members. We want you to have all of the information you need before you vote. The Phase Two Committee members are Johnny Quinn (chair), Anne Jones, David Moore, Jack Morris, Sherry Purtle, and Carolyn Tanneberger. I have also updated the Phase 2 information on the church website: www.fbcfayetteville.org.

Pray for God's wisdom as we seek His will and direction. The committee has been praying and will make their recommendation during the special called business meeting on Sunday, October 10. Please make every effort to come, hear the discussions, ask your questions, and vote as one people.
