The original design of a cupola and bell was beautiful, but the costs continued to spiral upward (the last estimate was \$140,000 plus the cost of the bells). Many other considered plans of cupolas and steeples were not inspiring and still had unappealing costs (over \$100,000). I believe you will be excited by the design and pleased with the cost of less than \$90,000. It is a creative design that matches the character of our church and will honor the Lord.
