Did You Know?...

Helen Eaton, a teacher at Holcomb Elementary School has been named Arkansas English Elementary Teacher of the Year by the Arkansas Council of Teachers of English and Language Arts.

She was nominated by Chris Goering, assistant professor of secondary English and literacy education at the University of Arkansas, and selected for the award based on her teaching innovations, research, publication and service to her students, parents and professional membership organizations, according to a news release from the council.

Eaton has co-edited two books, "Spark the Brain, Ignite the Pen: Quick Writes for Kindergarten Through High School Teachers and Beyond" and "The Flavor of Our Words."

She has 23 years experience in teaching second through fourth grades and has been a Northwest Arkansas Writing Project teacher-consultant for workshops and writing conferences held at the University of Arkansas, and on sites of various school districts for the past 10 years.

Eaton will receive her award on Nov. 13 during the council's fall conference.


