- Bibles

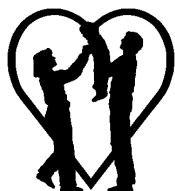
Collection boxes will be at the Information Center and in other locations around the church until December 15.

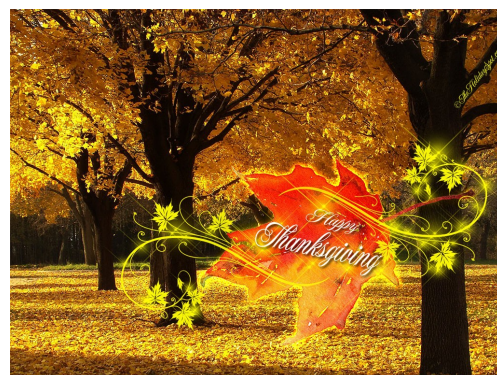

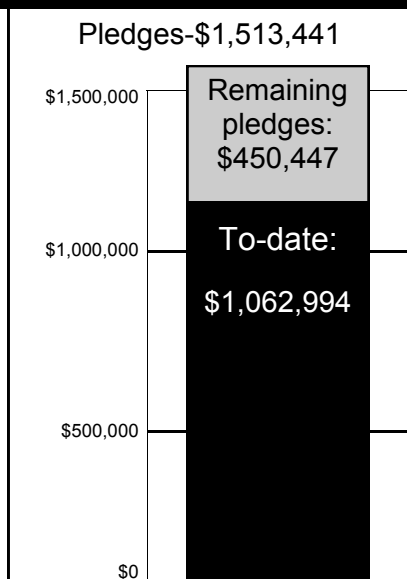
