



....just a reminder

This is the time of year many of you will begin to review your end-of-the-year financial affairs. It is important to note:

► To be recorded as a tax-deductible contribution for the year 2008, contributions and gifts must be in the church office or postmarked no later than December 31, 2008.



- ► Contributions that are placed in the church offering the first worship service of 2009 will not qualify as a charitable contribution in 2008, even if the check is predated to 2008 or was actually written in 2008.
- ► Checks that are postmarked in 2008 will be deductible in 2008 even if the church does not receive them until after January 1, 2009.

Although cash and checks are the most frequent manner of giving there are other methods of giving that are very appropriate for both the giver and the church. Many find that financial market prices have risen in value over the original purchase price on certain stocks, bonds and mutual funds. Gifts of securities can provide donors with a dual tax benefit. First, a charitable contribution deduction may be claimed in the amount of the current market value of the donated stock. That is, the donor may deduct the original cost of the donated shares and also the amount of any appreciation in the value of those shares. Second, donors avoid paying taxes on the appreciated value of the donated stock, so the entire amount of the gift furthers the mission of the church. If you want to use appreciated properties to make a donation, do so by year-end to qualify for a potential tax deduction.

Also, the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act recently signed into law, extended through 2009 the opportunity for people who are at least 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ years old to give from either a traditional or Roth IRA account directly to the church without the donor having to claim the money as income.

Whatever the method of giving, the gift reflects the spirit of love and devotion to God who supplies all our needs, including the most important gift of new life in Jesus Christ.



We will have a baked potato & chili supper with hot dogs for the kids. We are planning to sing Christmas carols, eat cookies and celebrate the true meaning of Christmas.


