This deposit is non-refundable. Payment plans are available.

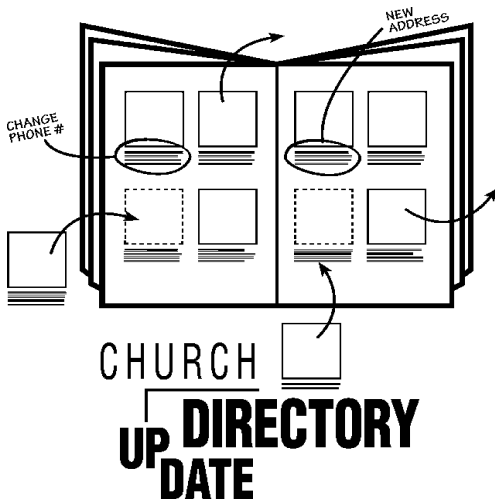
We only have 20 spots available - 10 girls & 10 boys.

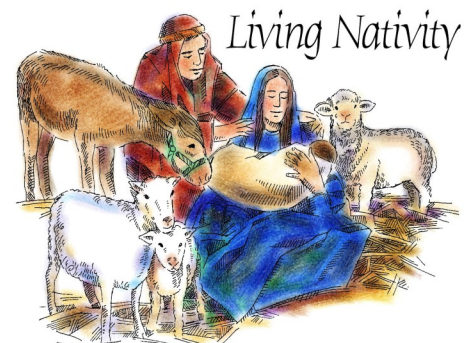

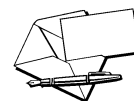
