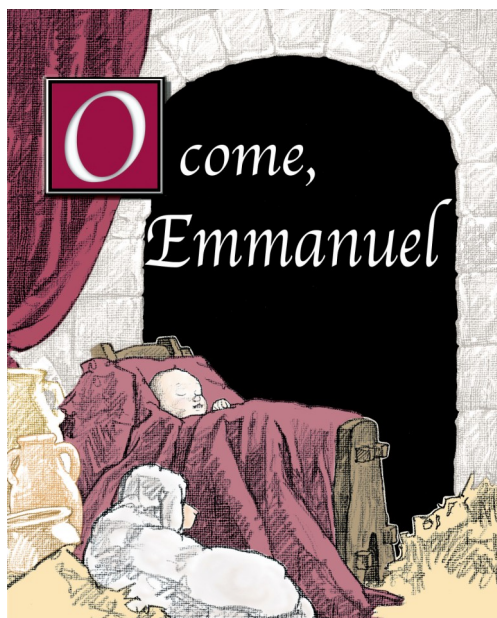

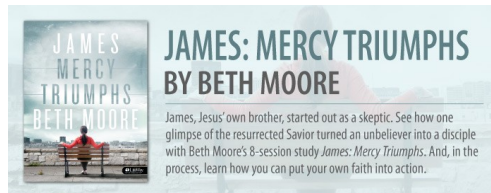
Event Change!

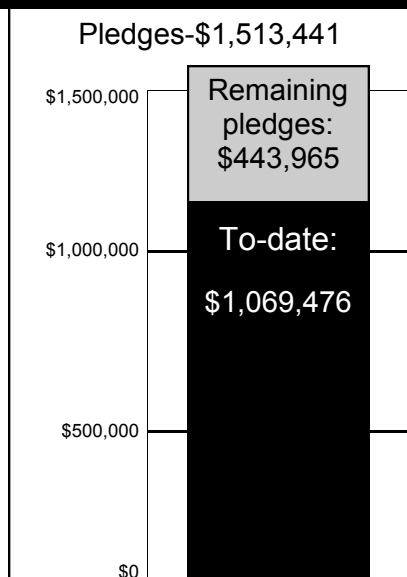
