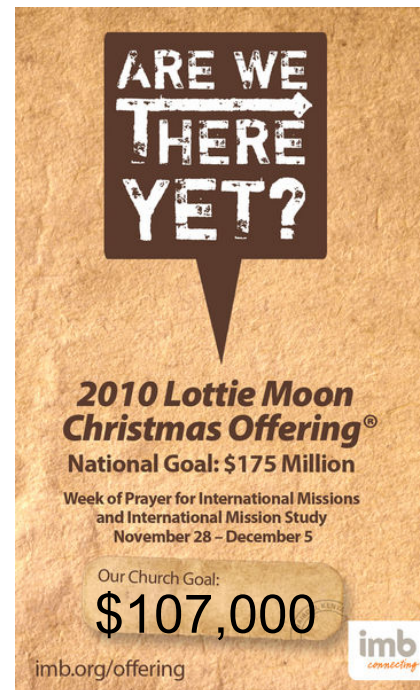


Eight members of our
