
Eight members of our

needs to be filled with the following items: shampoo/ cream rinses, non-aerosol hair spray, combs/brushes, tissues, toothbrushes/ pastes,




stationary, greeting cards, white crew socks, candy, religious tracts/books/devotionals. Please provide one or more boxes as a witness for our Lord.
