Vacation time is nice. Royce Ann and I enjoyed being away for a few days. Thanks to our fine church staff for picking up the slack.

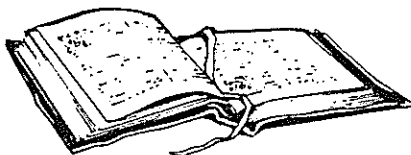
