

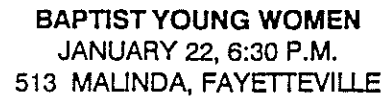

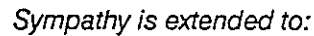

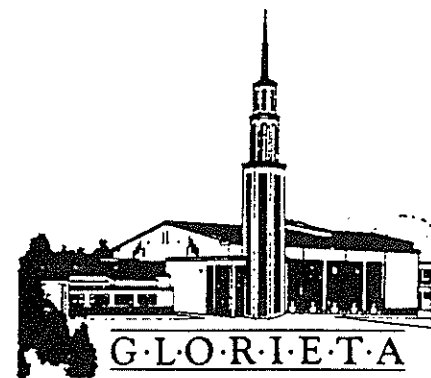


Student Week at Glorieta Sign-up!
